

Manchester Wellness Coalition

Timeline of Events – as of April 11, 2011

February 2010	CWF - conducts presentation for Manchester Community leaders
March 2010	CWF - Joint Village Council and School Board meeting 3/1 with CWF presentation and survey tasks. Initial members form group to respond. Follow-up review at MACC meeting 3/8 yields further recruits for effort.
March 2010- April 2010	MWC – interested parties get together to form group approach and strategy for Manchester wellness planning, and a coordinated response to CWF grant opportunities. Coalition completes the Healthy Communities Checklist input (MDCH), and also considers several projects/programs/topics for possible support by the MWC.
June 2010	MWC – hosts booth at Community Business Expo in partnership with CWF and CCH Healthy Communities. Further promotion to community via <i>Manchester Enterprise</i> articles, Golf Outing CWF sponsorship
August 2010	MWC – submits the State of Michigan Promoting Active Communities (PAC) and Nutrition Environment Assessment Tool (NEAT) surveys in conjunction with CWF
July 2010- November 2010	MWC – Manchester Community Schools receives \$ 60,000 CWF grant to facilitate refurbishment and upgrade of Middle School fitness center into a community asset. Subgroup of MWC conducts public visioning meeting, reviews different models for upgrades and promotion to the community, develops preliminary financial data, requests input from Power Wellness regarding becoming Chelsea Wellness Center “satellite”
September 2010- November 2010	CWF – restructures approach with “Comprehensive Wellness Initiative” and recommends “Community Wellness Coalitions”, based partly on model used in Albert Lea, MN, and on Foundation’s reconsideration of long-term objectives for the five communities
November 2010- February 2011	MWC – expands coverage and numbers of MWC membership. Completes the Manchester Community Assessment and submits to CWF.
February 2011	MWC - begins resource mapping relative to the four 5H goals
March 2011	MWC – interviewed by CWF Comprehensive Wellness Committee regarding the Community Assessment, and receives review letter from CWF on Manchester’s readiness. MWC also receives guidance on Wellness Coalition Planning Process.
