Safe Routes to School – Manchester

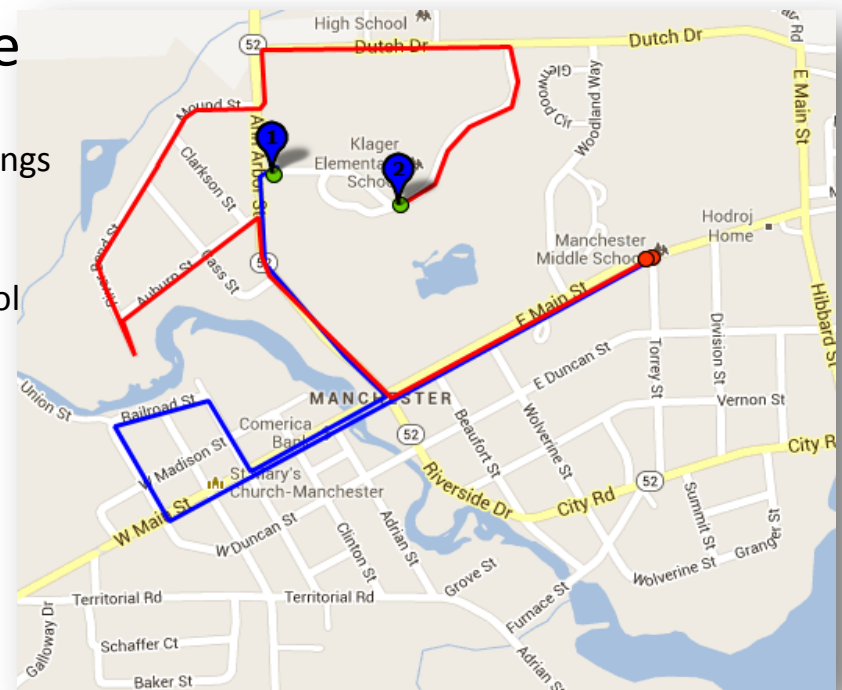
Accomplishments

- SR2S Infrastructure Grant submitted to MDOT
- Walk to School day conducted
- Bike to School day scheduled
- Bike Rodeo conducted
- Scheduled and currently conducting Walk to School Wednesdays



Safe Routes to School Grant – MDOT

- Application submitted to MDOT in late 2014.
- Proposed improvements include
 - Crossing on Ann Arbor Street by Klager
 - New or replaced sidewalks and pedestrian crossings in Woodland Way subdivision
 - Along Duncan from Adrian to Torrey
 - Torrey from Duncan to Manchester Middle School
 - Washington/Madison
- Total Grant Request - \$397,000
 - Pending decision late January



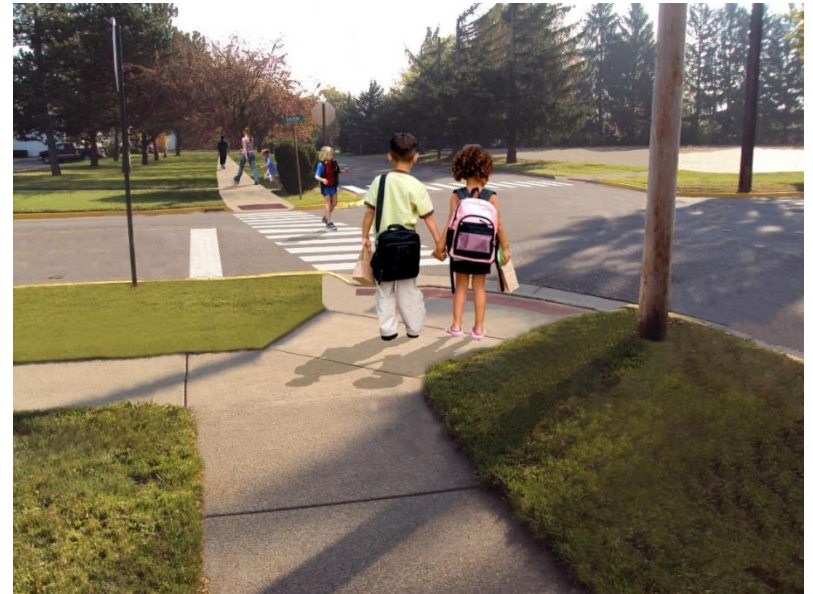
Safe Routes to School Grant – MDOT

Safe Routes to School Grant – MDOT

- Non-infrastructure components
- Enforcement, Education and Encouragement
 - Enforcement – Portable radar sign to be used in locations around school zones
 - Education – mailers and maps to go home to parents RE: the new safe routes
 - Encouragement – portable bike racks for both school building
